

Terms and conditions

ANU Postgraduate Information Exchange 2023 competition

- 1. The competition commences at 9am Tuesday 19 September 2023 and closes at 7:30pm Wednesday 18 October 2023 (promotional period). Taking part in this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 2. The promoter of this competition is The Australian National University, Canberra (ABN 52234063906).
- 3. The competition is open to any prospective undergraduate or postgraduate ANU student who registers and attends ANU Postgraduate Information Exchange on Wednesday 18 October 2023. There is a limit of one entry per person.
- 4. To enter, eligible entrants must complete and submit their 2023 ANU Postgraduate Information Exchange event registration via https://study.anu.edu.au/events/postgraduate-information-exchange during the promotional period and check-in to the ANU Postgraduate Information Exchange event between 5pm and 7:30pm on Wednesday 18 October 2023.
- 5. There will be one winner of the competition (winner). The winner shall be drawn at random from the eligible entries received by a staff member of The Australian National University. The draw will take place at Level 6, 121 Marcus Clarke Street, ANU Acton campus, on Thursday 26 October 2023.
- 6. The winner will be notified by phone and in writing by, using the mobile number and email address provided in the registration form, within seven days of the draw date. The winner must claim their prize in the manner set out in the email informing them that they have won. No correspondence will be entered into. The promoter's draw is final.
- 7. There will be one prize to be won, consisting of a 13-inch MacBook Air (8GB unified memory and 256GB SSD storage) valued at AUD \$1,499.00.
- 8. If the prize remains unclaimed after two months of the draw date, the promoter will conduct an unclaimed prize draw in the same manner and place as the original. The winner from the original draw will be removed from the unclaimed prize draw.
- 9. The promoter accepts no responsibility for loss, damage, accident, death or injury resulting from the competition.
- 10. The prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash. The winner accepts the prize 'as is' and acknowledges that the promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from the prize winnings.
